Arthur Faucher said the Budget Committee had voted 7-0 in favor of waiving the ten-day notice to review the warrant.

5. Utilization of the Tax Anticipation Note and additional applications to the Town treasury

Arthur Faucher said that \$1 million of the TAN had been used and an additional \$500,000 would be used until the tax revenue began coming in.

## 6. Discussion on revaluation disparities

The chairman asked Board members to submit written comments on their concerns about the revaluation and distribute them to other members before the weekend. The comments will be discussed on Tuesday, October 2, at a workshop following the regular meeting.
