MINUTES FROM MARCH 28, 2017

Meeting called to order at 1705.

Attendees: Ben Averill, Richard Forrest, David Gagnon, Susan Robson, Frank Sprague.

Reviewed Feb. minutes, approved same and changed meeting time to 1730 from 1700.

Vendor application reviews:

Approved "Forgotten Recipes" permit. Vendor requests positioning bldg.. close to North end of pier by swapping places with "Potters Shed".

Approved "Wiscasset Area Chamber of Commerce" permit and recommended fee be waived.

Approved "Sprague's Lobster" permit.

Approved "QT's Ice Cream Parlor" permit.

Info and discussion with vendor:

Power supply located on pole that supplies QT's should be locked. Town bathrooms not being cleaned enough.. Signs should be placed on RT.1 for each vendor.

David will look into sign requirements with code officer.

Approved "The Potter's Shed" permit. Vendor okay with swapping positions.

Approved "Maine Kayak, Inc." Due to requiring two locations the committee recommended 30'by34' for \$600.

"Doublet Design" permit tabled due to bldg.. proposed exceeds the 20'by10' size. Ben will check with vendor.

Other business:

Recommend to selectmen: move WACC bldg. 6' north to clear signs.

Pump out station contents can be pumped out and transported to Waste Treatment Facility for proper disposal.

David checked with State Surplus Property about availability of a boat for the Harbormaster. Boat would be free to the Town if available in April.
