### WISCASSET PLANNING BOARD MINUTES, JANUARY 28, 2019

### 1. Call to Order

## 2. Approval of Minutes of December 10, 2018

# <u>3. Zaremba Program Development, LLC – Site Plan Review for demolition of existing building and construction of new Dollar General retail store, 277 & 279 Bath Road, Map U11, Lot 21, 22</u>

Matt Casey of the Zaremba Group explained that the 9,100-square foot Dollar General store planned would be a convenience store, not a dollar store, with general merchandise – a packaged groceries, cards, toiletries, etc. Huber's store will be demolished, there will be a single driveway and truck deliveries will be in the rear. The store will be open seven days a week from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., although hours may be adjusted depending on traffic in the store. The parking lot and outside store lights will be turned off a half hour after closing.

Chris Nadeau, Nobis Engineering, said the 8-acre lot including the site of the restaurant will be divided with 1-1/3 acres utilized for the store and the remainder for the restaurant. He described the access to the site which will be shared with the adjacent Ship's Chow Hall. A waiver will be sought from the 3% grade as the new driveway will have a 5% grade to match the proposed grades. The project will have town water and sewer. A stormwater detention pond is planned. Permits from the DOT for the driveway and from the DEP for a stormwater permit will be necessary as well as letters from the water and sewer departments. A Concord Bus stop is not planned.

A site visit by Al Cohen, Deb Pooler, Tony Gatti and Jason Putnam was scheduled for Thursday, February 7 at 4 p.m. A public hearing will be held on February 25; the applicant will notify the abutters.

### 4. Other Business

Copies of an application from Atlantic Environmental, LLC for a fixed pier with seasonal ramp and float, which will be on the next meeting's agenda, were distributed.
