

The Wiscasset Historical Preservation Commission met on February 7 at 4:58 P.M. Present were Chairman John Reinhardt, Gordon Konrath, Leslie Roberts and Pam Logan. Members introduced themselves.

Minutes were amended by Gordon Konrath to include names of committee members. His motion was accepted and approved.

Old Business

COA for Snyder: Rick Snyder 190 Main Street Wiscasset presented his application to replace 29 windows at this location with aluminum storm windows, doubled glazed and double hung. This excluded the two picture windows facing Main Street. Mr. Snyder remarked that other nearby buildings have similar windows.

Pam asked what would become of the old windows and that often people would purchase them. Snyder said they would be taken away by the company.

Leslie noted that she preferred restoring the two front windows with wooden windows rather than using vinyl replacements.

It was moved by Leslie Roberts and seconded to table this COA until the Snyder's submitted an alternate plan for the front windows of the house. Motion carried.

Pam and Leslie are working on the WHC web page. Leslie noted that the HPC is on the town web site.

Chairman Reinhardt told the committee that Mr. West had expected to be at this meeting. His paper work is not complete, that of dealing with abutters. No work by the committee can be done until his COA is completed.

New Business

The question was raised as to what should be presented to the Select Board regarding a Commission budget which goes through the office of Kathleen Onorato. Should it include funds for the 250th anniversary celebration of Wiscasset? Leslie presented a list of items.

No word concerning a town gazebo has come from its committee. Consideration of an alternate location was discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:37.
