There is a need to change Pier Policy as there is a difference between Piers: proximity to Route 1, water available at the Rec. Pier and no water at the Main Street Pier. Pier policy review will be ongoing throughout the year.

Harbor Master Report:

The Town bathrooms will be open by 5-12-17.

There is a need to set a fee for use of the Rec. Pier by fishermen outside of the normal boating season. That season is from Memorial Day to Oct. 1st.The committee recommended a fee of \$100 for this usage. Voted on and approved.

Pump out Station: Need a fee structure for usage by public. Ben will research time frame of grant and will check with DEP for any input from them.

Preston will check on regulatory agency. Results of this research will be presented to selectmen in June.

Preston will check with the Town Manager for proper method of removing abandoned moorings and dealing with the owners of the moorings.

Discussed if there is a need for water front gear such as shackles, rope, buoys etc. that could be available to be purchased by the public. No decision made.

A presentation about the sculpture of "Hesper" will be made to selectmen by Nick Dalton on 5-16-17.

Rock Lobster Relay is scheduled for Sat. June 24th. Volunteers are requested to man a station for the race.

David will fill the flower planter boxes with compost.

Preston will check on any electrical boxes not locked at the Rec. Pier.

The kayak race will end at the Rec. Pier at approximately 1300 on July 4th.

Susan read letter of appreciation for Town Planner.
